### Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 285 includes much of northern McLeod and southern Meeker counties with smaller portions of western Carver and southern Wright counties. This DPA contains excellent deer habitat provided by wooded shorelines and marshlands mixed with agricultural areas. Population data indicate that the deer herd growth rate has stabilized and is presently at the goal established in 2023. The 2 deer per season bag limit will continue to maintain this population status.
