Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 285 includes much of northern McLeod and southern Meeker counties with smaller portions of western Carver and Wright counties. The mix of agricultural land use and wooded areas associated with lakes and wetlands provides excellent deer habitat within this DPA. Population modeling indicates the deer herd in this area is capable of rapid growth, however it remains at the recently established population goal. The current bag limit of 2 deer per season will be continued to maintain this population status.
