Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 287 is comprised entirely of Itasca State Park encompassing more than 32,000 acres, including mostly mature mixed forests with numerous lakes and wetlands. Hunters can pursue deer in this area during the regular firearm and muzzleloader seasons to help manage deer so that pine can be regenerated and ecological health maintained. The area is not open to archery deer hunting. The 2024 One deer either-sex designation is meant to maintain antlerless harvest opportunity and lower deer numbers to meet ecological restoration goals.
