Deer Permit Area (DPA) 338 has productive deer habitat containing a mixture of agricultural land, prairie, wetlands, upland forest, bluffland forest and floodplain forest. The Minnesota River and its tributaries bisect this permit area creating corridors of good habitat. DPA 338 has shown stabilizing deer populations with buck harvest increasing from 2021 to 2022. DPA 338 will have a Two-deer bag limit again in 2023 which provides consistency going into goal setting process in 2023, helping to have a better understanding of the population.
