Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 643 is located on the west edge of the driftless area, a rugged region of bluffs and valleys that contains some of the state's best deer habitat. Most of DPA 643 is privately owned, but there are both large and small State Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) available for public hunting in addition to a limited amount of State Forest land. Some of the WMAs in this DPA have restrictions on legal weapon types - please refer to the 2025 hunting regulations and the MN DNR Recreation Compass for details. DPA 643 is a designated CWD Disease Management DPA. However, deer populations in DPA 643 appear to be at or slightly above the goal set in 2021 to stabilize the population based on buck harvest and hunter success rates. Thus, a 5-Deer limit with an Early Antlerless season designation will be implemented in 2025 to continue to keep this area close to goal. Hunters may tag up to three bucks in this DPA - one each with an archery, firearms, and/or muzzleloader license. Please refer to the hunting regulations for details regarding carcass movement restrictions, CWD sampling protocols, and DNR-provided carcass dumpsters and quartering stations.

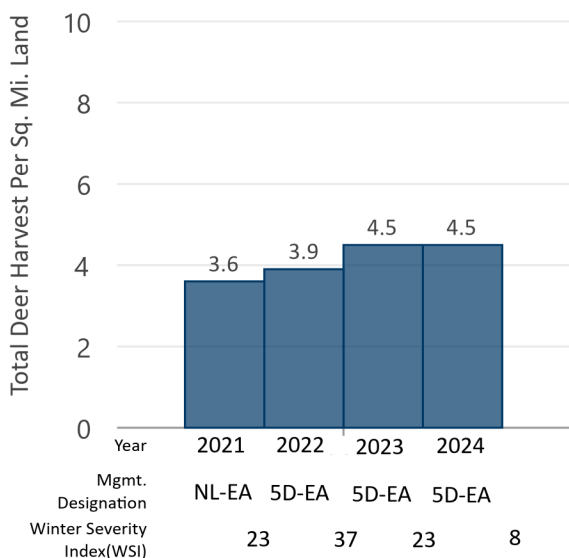

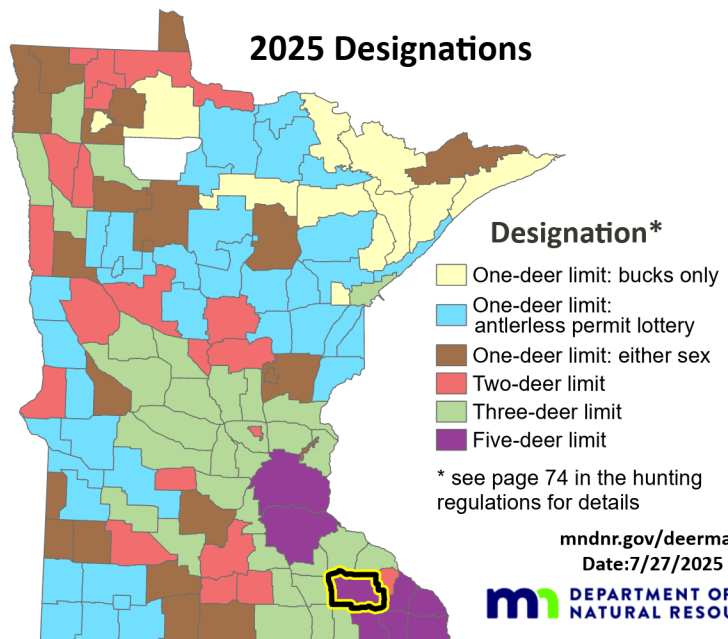
