Wildlife Manager Report

Deer permit area (DPA) 649 is located in the heart of the driftless area, a region of bluffs and valleys that makes up some of the states best deer habitat. DPA 649 is a designated Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) Management DPA. Please refer to the regulations for details regarding carcass movement restrictions, CWD sampling protocols, and DNR provided carcass dumpsters and quartering stations. Up to three bucks may be tagged-one each with archery, firearms, and muzzleloader licenses. DPA 649 is mostly privately owned but there are some large Wildlife Management Areas (WMA's) including Choice and Yucatan WMA's, and some large blocks of State Forest. Please see the 2023 hunting regulations and the DNR Recreation Compass for details.

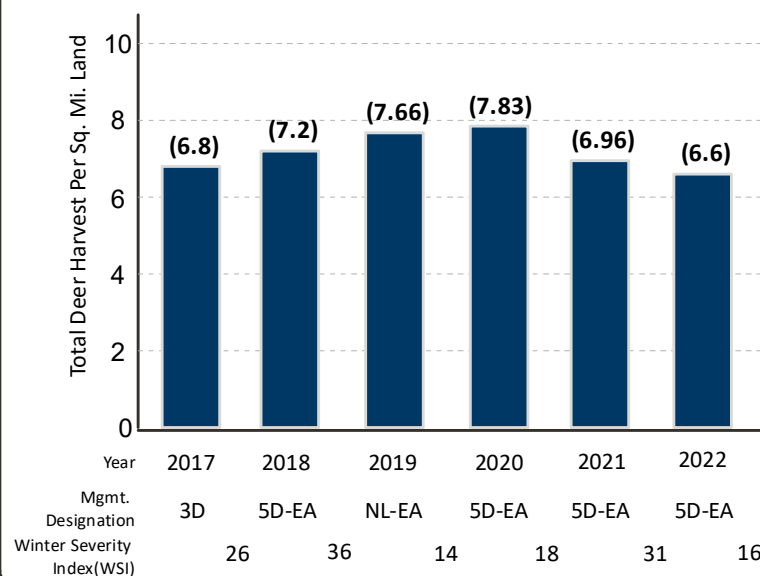

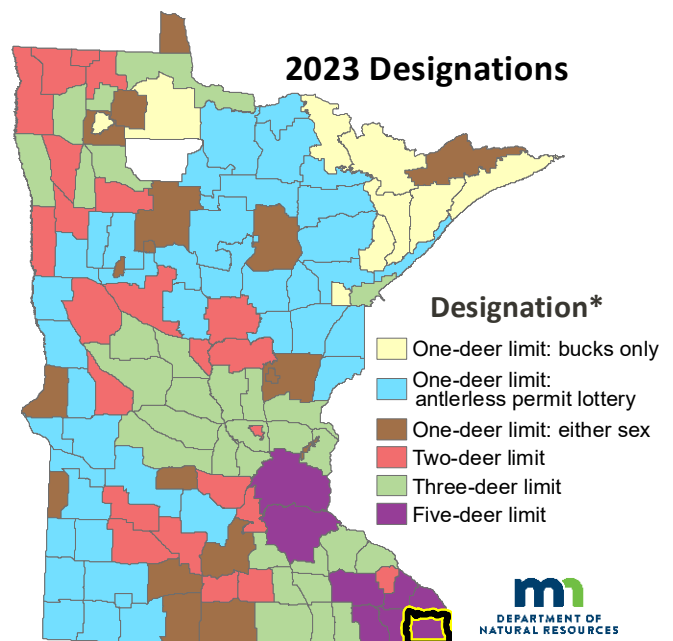
