

DEPUTY REGISTRAR DISABILITY ENDORSEMENT DESIGNATION GUIDELINES

TYPE 1 DISABLED ANGLER - DRIVER'S LICENSE /MINNESOTA ID ENDORSEMENT

In accordance with Minnesota Statute 171.07 Subd. 17 we may issue an applicant a driver's license or Minnesota identification card with a type 1 physical disability endorsement designation based on specific medical conditions. The endorsement validates the individual's eligibility to receive a free angling and spearing license by meeting statutory requirements.

These eligible medical conditions can be:

1. **Blind:** The applicant should show documentation from a medical provider declaring they are permanently blind.
2. **A recipient of workers' compensation due to a finding of total and permanent disability:** Applicant must provide documentation confirming the person is receiving workers compensation benefits from being found totally and permanently disabled.
3. **Age 65 or older and qualified as a recipient of Supplemental Security Income for the aged, blind, and disabled; or as a recipient of Social Security aid to the disabled under specified US Code:** This requires documentation from Social Security Administration identifying the person was disabled at age 64.
4. **Permanently disabled and meets the disability requirements for Supplemental Security Income or Social Security aid to the disabled under specified US Code:** This requires documentation from a medical provider that declares the person's disability for which they are receiving social security benefits is permanent.
