

Volunteer Tennesen Notice and Health Screening Questions

Tennesen Notice

Before entering the worksite, all DNR volunteers will be asked a series of questions. This data is classified as private under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act. We will use this data to screen individuals before they enter the worksite for potential health risks to try to avoid the potential of spreading COVID-19. The data helps us to determine whether risk factors are present and whether you will be denied admission for the protection of other volunteers, agency staff and/or the public. This is not a COVID-19 test and is not a determination of whether or not an individual is infected with or has been exposed to COVID-19. This data will be gathered and reviewed by agency staff, including non-medical personnel, in deciding whether to permit you admission to agency volunteer sites. You are not legally required to provide this data and providing the data is voluntary. However, if you refuse to provide the data, you will not be admitted to agency worksites. The data collected from you may be shared with agency staff collecting the data, agency Human Resources staff, the agency safety administrator, agency management, and other persons or entities authorized by law.

Health Screening Questions

1. **Symptoms:** In the past 10 days, have you had any of the following COVID-19 symptoms that you cannot attribute to another health condition? Fever of 100.4 °F or higher or feeling feverish or new chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, muscle aches not related to exercise, headache, loss of taste or smell, nausea/vomiting or diarrhea.
2. **Positive Test:** Have you had a positive COVID-19 test based on a sample taken in the last 10 days?
3. **Recent Contact Within Your Household:** Has anyone you **live with** had a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 24 days (since they began COVID-19 symptoms OR, if they have not had any COVID-19 symptoms, since they got tested with a positive result?)
4. **Recent Contact Outside of Your Household:** In the past **14 days**, have you been exposed to someone you **don't live with** who has a confirmed case of COVID-19? This means that either you have had direct contact with someone with COVID-19, or you have been less than 6 feet from someone with COVID-19 for 15 minutes or more throughout a 24-hour period.

Before reporting to the volunteer site, please text or call your volunteer supervisor to acknowledge you have:

- ***read the Tennesen Notice and***
- ***answered "yes" or "no" to the health screening questions.***

Do not provide medical information of any kind.

If you answer "Yes" to any of these questions, you are *not* authorized to report to your volunteer position. Stay away from other people and contact your health care provider.
