


## PROTECTED WATERS AND

The boundaries of the protected water bodies shown on this map are plotted as accurately as possible, consistent with the map scale, but are still approximate. A protected water body boundary coincides with the ordinary high water mark of the water body as defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 105.37 and is determined through DNR field inspec-
