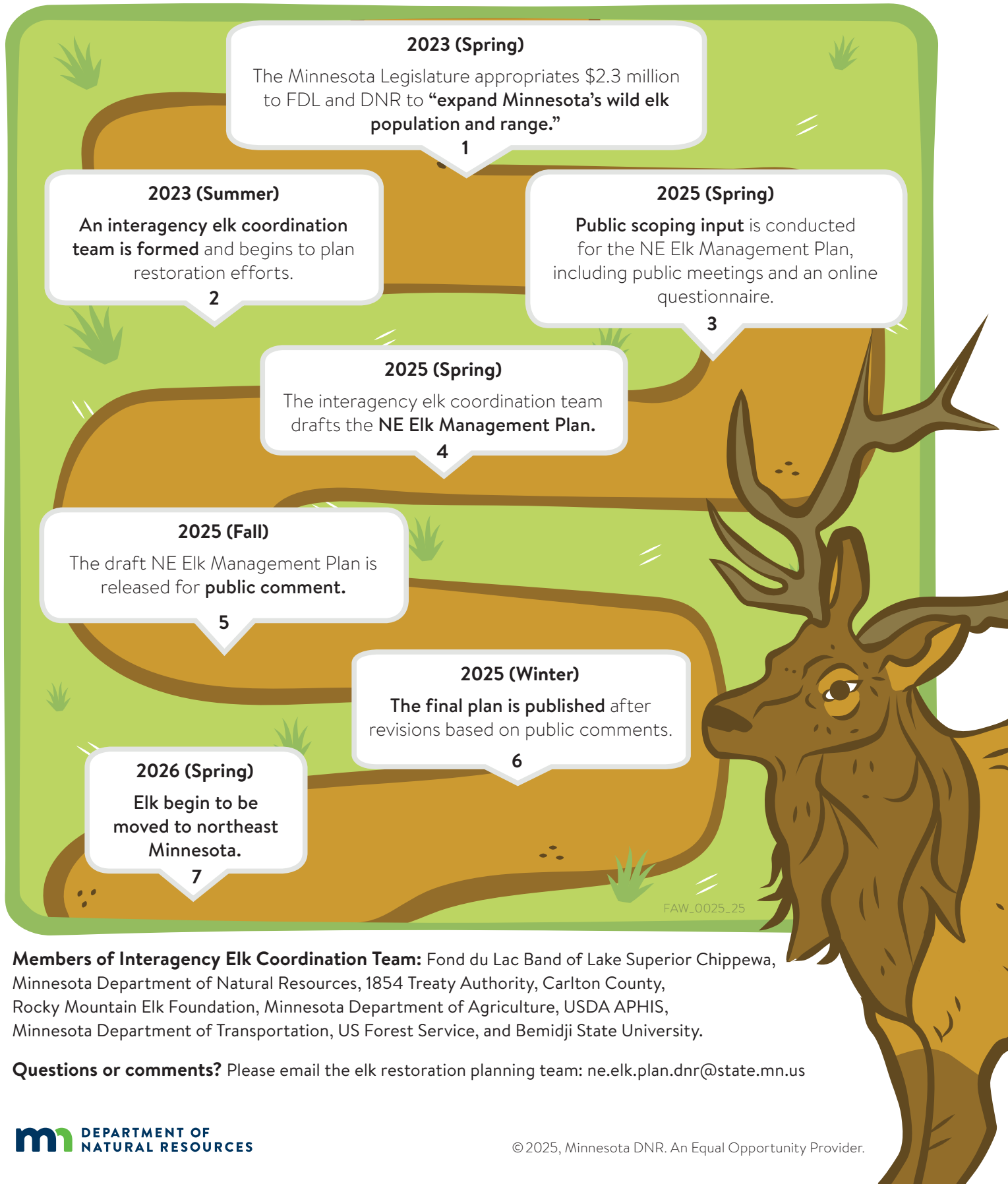


Elk planning and research timeline

With support and direction from the Minnesota Legislature, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is a partner with the Fond du lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa (FDL) on the Band's proposal to restore elk to the Fond du Lac Reservation, the 1854 Ceded Territory, and surrounding area in northeast Minnesota.
