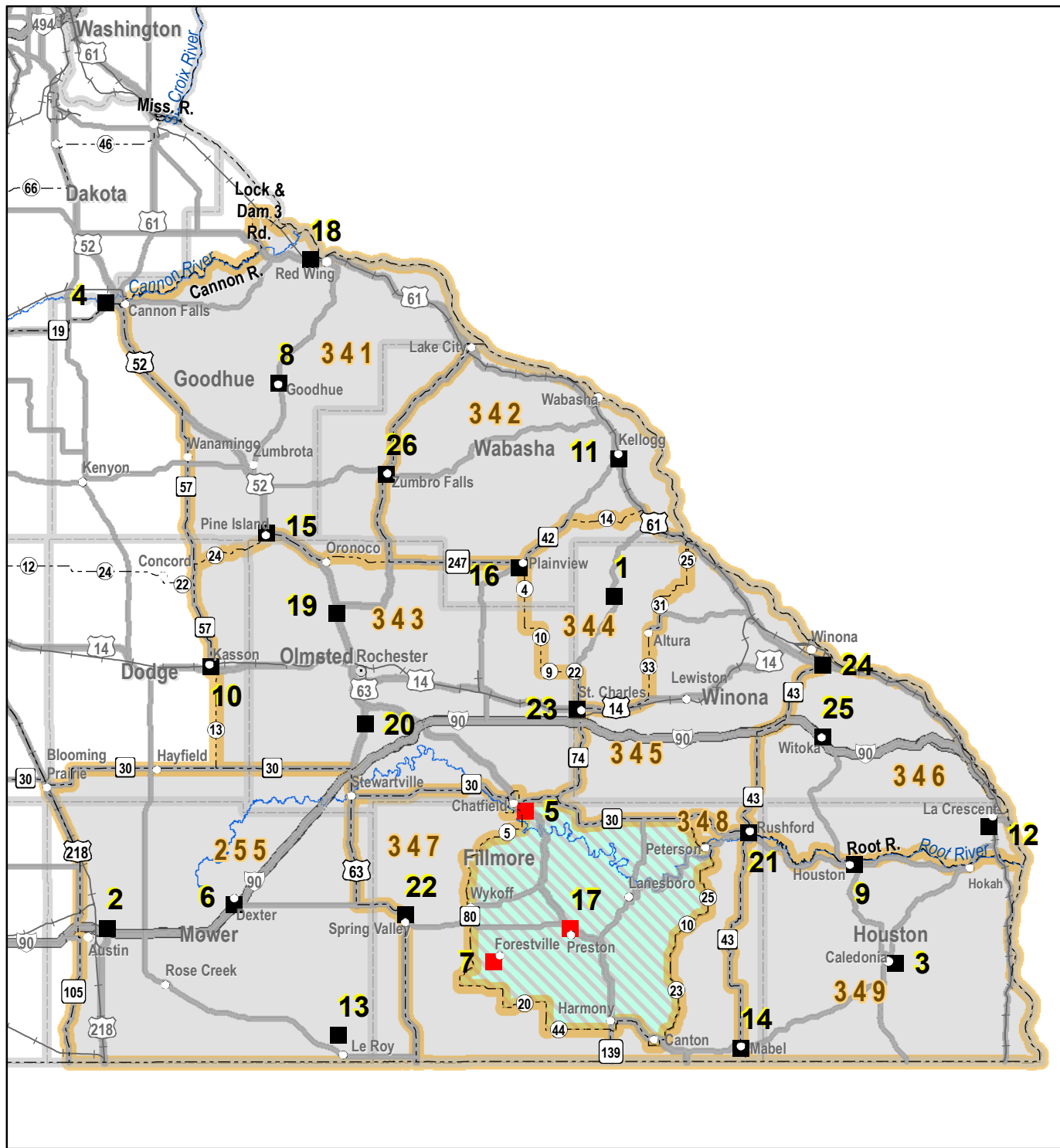


## Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) Sampling Locations for the SE Surveillance Area

 - November 3-4. All of DPA 255  
 - November 3-4 and November 17-18. All of DPAs 341, 342, 343, 344, 345, 346, 347, 348, and 349  
**Station Hours:** 9AM - 8PM

**How to prepare for CWD Sampling**  
 - Register your deer prior to sampling via the internet, phone or walk-in registration.  
 - Be able to locate the location of your harvested deer on a map to identify township, range and section.  
 - Position deer with head toward the back of the vehicle so it is accessible for sampling.
